COMES NOW, Neil C. Gordon, Chapter 7 Trustee (the "Trustee") for the bankruptcy estate of Clauio Pablo Avendano (the "Estate"), and files this *Objection to Exemptions* ("Objection"), and in support thereof shows this Honorable Court the following:

1. Clauio Pablo Avendano ("Debtor") filed *pro se* under penalty of perjury a voluntary petition for relief under Chapter 7 of Title 11 U.S.C. on August 3, 2015 (the "Petition Date"), thereby initiating Case No. 15-64523-PWB (the "Case").
